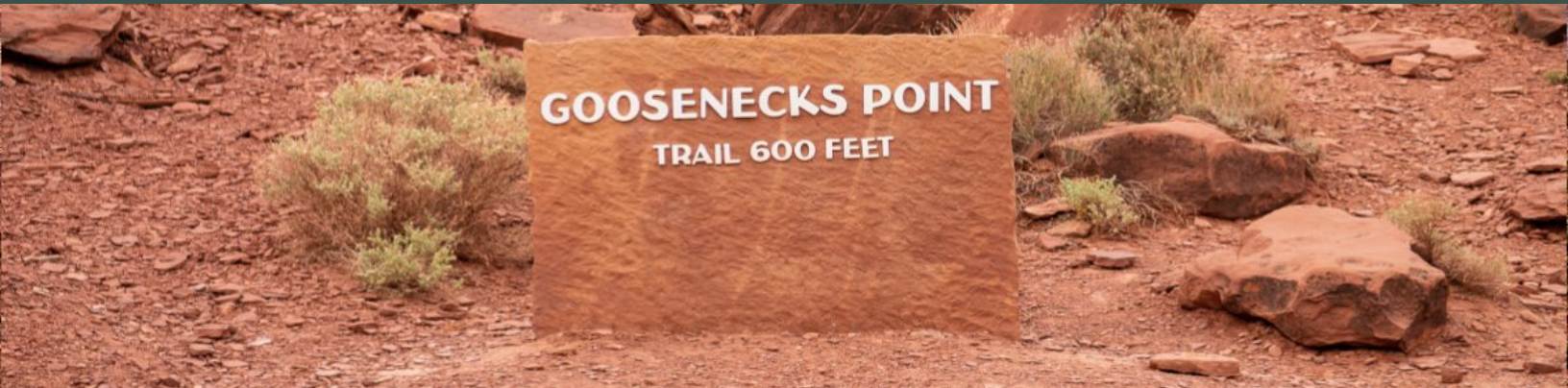


Goosenecks Overlook

A short walk to the edge of an 800-foot drop.

CAPITOL REEF COUNTRY TRAIL GUIDE



0.2 miles

DISTANCE

30 ft

ELEVATION GAIN

Easy

DIFFICULTY

10-15 min

EST. TIME

LOCATION

Capitol Reef National Park, near Sunset Point.

TRAIL TYPE

Out-and-back.

TRAIL DESCRIPTION

A short walk to a railed overlook above an 800-foot vertical drop where Sulphur Creek has carved hairpin switchbacks through Moenkopi sandstone over millions of years. Pairs well with nearby Sunset Point.

DIFFICULTY NOTES

Minimal physical exertion required; maximum visual drama delivered.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

No dogs allowed; fees required. Pack out everything you pack in. Flash floods can hit canyons fast from distant storms — check the forecast first.

COORDINATES

38.29868, -111.29897 (Trailhead)

Coordinates are a navigation aid — conditions change, so always verify current road and trail status before you go.

SAFETY

Check forecasts for flash floods; stay on designated trails to protect fragile desert crusts.

TRAIL TIP

Pair it with Sunset Point next door — they share a parking area and together take less than an hour.
